- "We the People of Holyoke" explores how Holyoke residents across four centuries have lived out and expanded upon the ideals of the American Revolution.
- "Labor, Lawrence, and the Promises" of the Revolution is an art program for high school students that explores the legacies of the American Revolution through Lawrence's industrial history.
- "Queering the Revolution" is a new podcast profiling revolutionary trailblazers in the Massachusetts LGETQ+ community from the Revolution to the first Boston Pride.
- Mashpee Old Indian Meeting House explores how the promises of liberty and equality were denied to Indigenous peoples – and how Wampanoag citizens have continued to assert sovereignty and cultural resilience.
